The purpose of the Sumter School District's Code of Conduct is to establish a culture which achieves safe schools, creates a culture conducive to learning, and maintains order in the schools. In district policy ARJICDA-R, the Board and the Administration provide categories of offenses, and recommended disciplinary dispositions are included for each category.

The categories are as follows:

- Category I (one) Offenses (least severe)
- Category II (two) Offenses (less severe)
- Category III (three) Offenses (more severe; result in suspension)
- Category IV (four) Offenses (most severe; expulsion recommendation)

Parents/guardians should be aware that the school has provided formal instruction for your child which supports his/her understanding of the Code of Conduct for the 2017-2018 school year. In addition, your child has received a copy of the Code of Conduct which can be found in his/her student handbook. You are respectfully requested to review the document with your child. If needed, contact your child's teacher or an administrator with any concerns or questions that you may have.
